

Tarot Time Travels Lesson 2 The Power of Clarity: Symbols, Energy, and Tarot Timing Transcript

Welcome back, and thank you for continuing. Your commitment to learning how to travel through time with Tarot is great! I'm excited to share it with you. So, let's take a big breath through the nose and release it through your mouth. Wiggle your toes and give yourself a hug. Great, now we are here.

Subjectivity and How I Got Mine

To begin, I want to discuss the idea of subjectivity in Tarot readings. The material I am presenting is, of course, subjective to my own personal feelings and opinions. We all have our individual ways of reading Tarot. I am sharing how I read Tarot and built a successful practice over thirty years.

To clarify, one of the reasons I have retained clients since the beginning, some even referring their daughters to me, is because Tarot is not my only tool. I don't even use Tarot in my title, Psychic Astrologer. I utilize several tools, including Astrology, Numerology, Tarot, Pendulum, Channeling the Ascended Masters, Clairvoyance, and Empathy. When I read for someone, I first review their chart and determine what they are experiencing. This tells me what we are dealing with and sometimes indicates the probable outcome. Then, I turn to Tarot to answer my client's question. Even when a client asks for guidance and has no specific questions, I turn their query into a question I ask Tarot.

There is a question in the Tarot community about asking questions about other people. In Astrology, I have never heard of this issue being raised. Astrologers look at the charts of people the querant has questions about. We do it all the time. One of the questions people often ask is, "How does she or he feel about me?" I will ask that person how they feel about the querant, but I will preface my question with, "If it is the will of your soul to share, please tell me how you feel about this person." I do not have any ethical concerns about this. You may have a different view. I respect that.

I started my career in 1991 because I was obsessed with a man. Back then, there was little internet and no large platforms for psychic readings. Instead, we had 900 lines. I spent a lot of money on those platforms. Many of the psychics I contacted were not as skilled as I was at reading Tarot or providing clear and accurate psychic insights. This told me it was time for me to offer readings.

Before that, I had studied metaphysics. My primary studies were at a school led by Lisa de Longchamps, Wingsong. Lisa taught Manifesting and Channeling, as well as several other subjects. She was an incredible Channeler and worked with the Ascended Masters. As a

The scales in the stonework above the elder man represent justice and the earned nature of the old man's success.

The tower carved in the stonework, reminiscent of The Tower card, symbolizes past struggles and challenges overcome.

The castle, also intricately carved into the stonework, holds much symbolic significance. In an esoteric context, castles symbolize spiritual fortification, inner strength, and the quest for higher wisdom. They represent the soul's journey toward enlightenment, often signifying a protected inner sanctuary where divine knowledge and truth reside. Castles are often seen as repositories of ancient wisdom, hidden truths, or spiritual secrets that require initiation to access.

The castle can signify divine authority, spiritual kingship, or the connection between the initiate and higher realms. In alchemy and mysticism, the "Inner Castle" is sometimes used as a metaphor for self-realization, where one must navigate through different chambers of the self to attain the ultimate truth.

The arch, a common architectural element, carries significant symbolic meaning across various cultures. Arches are often associated with triumph and victory, exemplified by iconic structures such as the Roman arches and the Arc de Triomphe in Paris, France. Passing through an arch is a symbolic act of renewal, marking the departure from the past. It represents a transition into a new phase of life. Arches frequently mark entrances to sacred spaces, signifying a transition from the mundane to the divine. Essentially, the arch symbolizes physical and spiritual passage, representing victory, rebirth, and access to something greater. It's essential to consider the relationship between the different figures on the card and the arch. The woman appears to be the only one completely on the other side. The man seems to be standing directly under it. Which way will he turn?



The dogs and their position symbolize unconditional love, loyalty, family devotion, and the enduring connection between generations. The dogs look toward the elder man; they know he is the "boss." Despite their age difference, the elder and the child share an interest in the dogs, both of whom are petting them, reminding us that children, adults, and all humans share common interests.

The dogs act as a "medium" between the old man and the child, mirroring the concept of intermediaries in spiritual communication. Their color, white, indicates that they are pure.

Grapes have been a powerful symbol across cultures and time, representing themes of abundance, transformation, divine connection, and the cyclical nature of life.

Grapes, often growing in large, lush clusters, symbolize fertility, prosperity, and wealth. Grapes undergo a significant transformation from fruit to wine, symbolizing change, alchemy, and sacrifice. In winemaking, grapes must be crushed and fermented to become something new, mirroring spiritual or personal metamorphosis. Grapes often represent spiritual growth and divine blessing in biblical and mystical traditions. For example, the grapevine image in Christianity signifies the connection between humanity and the divine, as seen in Jesus' words: "I am the vine; you are the branches." This speaks to unity, nourishment, and faith.

The headband worn by the woman is an emblem of success. Because it is made of flowers, it signifies her connection to the natural world. Headbands often symbolize control over the mind.

The elder's robes tell us that he is protected. They also contain two triple crosses, which are upside down but present next to the dog and the sleeve. The triple cross holds deep esoteric and spiritual significance across various traditions. Its symbolism varies depending on the context. Often associated with the Papal Cross, the triple cross represents the threefold authority of the Pope: Supreme Teacher (Doctrine), Supreme Legislator (Law), and Supreme Judge (Judgment). It can also symbolize the Holy Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).

In alchemy, the triple cross can represent the three stages of spiritual development. In Hermeticism, the triple cross signifies the union of body, mind, and spirit or the alignment of human will with divine will. In some Masonic and Templar traditions, the triple cross symbolizes the degrees of initiation or the mastery of esoteric knowledge. It also signifies a balance between the material and spiritual realms.

The triple cross is a powerful emblem of higher wisdom, divine authority, and the transformative journey toward enlightenment. However, in this case, they are upside down.

Just as an upright triple cross can represent divine authority (e.g., the Pope's power or the Holy Trinity), an inverted version may symbolize the rejection, corruption, or reversal of spiritual hierarchy. It could signify subversion of traditional doctrine or an alternative spiritual path that challenges mainstream beliefs.

There is a possibility of misinterpretation. Some may perceive an inverted triple cross as anti-Christian, but this is not always the case. While certain groups might use it to express opposition to the Church, in deeper esoteric thought, inversion does not always mean negation—it can signify transformation or revelation.

We must remember that A. E. Waite and Pamela Coleman Smith were members of The Golden Dawn. The Hermetic Order of the Golden Dawn was a melting pot of alchemy, Christian mysticism, Kabbalah, Egyptian magic, Freemasonry, and Eastern traditions. Their goal was spiritual enlightenment and personal transformation through ceremonial magic, meditation, and esoteric knowledge.

Rather than aligning with a single religion, the Golden Dawn sought to unite multiple mystical traditions into a unified system that allowed initiates to achieve gnosis (divine knowledge), self-mastery, and unity with the divine. Therefore, when a card incorporates a wealth of spiritual symbolism, as the Ten of Pentacles does, that symbolism is best observed.

In fact, there is more.

The stonework, the dress, and the elder's cloak show a black and red pattern. Once again, this may refer to the Freemasons, although I have not found any specific references to these color patterns in the tartans used by the Freemasons. I do not leave any pattern unnoticed, and because this one is drawn as part of the Triple Cross, I suspect Pamela Coleman Smith had a plan.

The pillar reminds us of the family's position as pillars of their community. Pillars are ancient symbols that represent strength, stability, duality, and the connections between the earthly and divine realms. Found in architecture, mythology, religion, and esoteric traditions, they serve as metaphors for physical and spiritual foundations.

Pillars are the backbone of structures, holding weight and maintaining balance. Because of this, they symbolize endurance, steadfastness, and reliability. In human terms, they represent leadership, responsibility, and unshakable moral character.

Many ancient civilizations erected pillars as monuments to commemorate events, rulers, or divine interventions. They serve as timeless markers of achievement, reminding future generations of their significance.

The colors red, orange, and blue play big roles in the card. Red signifies action and passion, while blue signifies truth and clarity. Orange symbolizes how individuals interact with the external world, focusing on physical needs and desires, as well as the means to fulfill them. It embodies the drive for external fulfillment, reflecting the individual's pursuit of material satisfaction and professional success. The child's white shoes refer to his grounded purity. The yellow in the card tells us that the mind is not unused in the family's dynamics.

This analysis of the Ten of Pentacles as a complex card with literal and symbolic meanings reflects various values and beliefs. Once again, I ask, where do your eyes fall? Your Highest Self is guiding them.

My point in discussing this is to illustrate how our subjectivity expands when we understand and acknowledge the symbols in the Tarot and their meanings.

But what do you do with this expanded subjectivity? If asking Tarot to time an event, this information enhances the answer. For example, what if you ask when a relationship will become an engagement and pull the Ten of Pentacles? The base answer would be 10 years. I'm guessing that is not going to be a welcomed answer. The Ten of Pentacles also explains why. "The extended family, or the potential fiancé, is concerned with continued success in business or career." If the party is already successful and has a child, the answer could be, "He's still very concerned and connected to his ex-wife, and he has his father to care for. They have a child, who is still young but fine." If he's still married, I don't think I have to keep going here. This leads to many other questions, and the querant can decide on a course of action. I'm hoping the querant is not hormonally driven by her biological clock. But she's not my client, so I don't have to worry about it. In the meantime, every answer can easily lead us down a rabbit hole. Before going down that hole, I suggest asking, "What is my best next step?" Because there is no future set in stone. The Tarot is going to reveal the probable outcome or timeframe. The future is ours to create.

In the meantime, given the incredible amount of symbolism in the card, additional questions could lead to profound guidance.

The beauty of Tarot is that it will work with you regardless of your subjectivity. Even with limited knowledge of the symbolism, the information we receive from Tarot usually proves valid. A limited view creates a limited view of outcomes, guidance, and clarity. However, we

can still receive guidance, and when an outcome or date is not given, it may have nothing to do with how deeply we understand the symbolism. It's essential to acknowledge that our choices influence outcomes. Additionally, we may encourage trips down the rabbit hole if we do not double-check the insights we gain through Tarot against multiple divination systems. A reader has the option of seeking guidance or sharing gossip.

The Tarot will understand your perspective and speak to you through that lens. Luckily, we are only dealing with timing. Timing is far more specific. It is numbers. Days, weeks, and seasons are all we need to time events. You can add the caveats that you recognize. Hopefully, as time passes, you will have all those insights available through a greater knowledge of the symbols. It is those caveats that further spiritual growth and healing.

One of the first pieces of advice I give to those I teach is to pay attention to where your eyes fall on the card. We will discuss later how this card times things. In the meantime, remember how The Empress card says, "Yes, I want to?" In the case of this card, where your eyes fall may add a caveat. For example, "Yes, (it is a yes card) because you have worked through and accomplished so much." That would be the case if your eyes fell on the tower in the stonework. Or "Yes, because he feels connected to you through spirit," if your eyes fall on the elder man and the child, and the dogs in between, connecting them.

Those added symbols are pearls of wisdom that readers can incorporate into their work, leading others or themselves to another step up the spiral.

A science fiction writer, Robert Heinlein, predicted that a time would come in the U.S. when a psychic would be on every block. He was right, though not in a literal sense. Instead of physical psychic shops, we ended up with multiple phone lines and, later, many virtual psychic establishments. Though I applaud the expansion of my industry, the current vehicles for delivering psychic services deny clients the basic advantage of Tarot readings. When done in person, the reader often shows the client the card. This may trigger subconscious memories in the querant, or their eyes may fall upon a specific symbol or illustration in the card. But, on the phone or in a chat, the client does not get that opportunity. This is one reason why I hope those open to Tarot as their vehicle for divination learn to read for themselves. Which is one of the reasons why I am offering this class.

Tarot is an intricate and multifaceted tool. We are starting with a very basic aspect. So don't freak out. Without understanding all of the symbolism you will be able to time events. I promise.

Ready? Set. Let's go.

The Grand Preparation

Before using your cards, I recommend clearing and charging them. Much like we do with crystals, I consecrate and bless them. I use candles and oils for these rituals. The recipes for the oils are ones I have developed myself. They are combinations of oils corresponding with all four elements and are gender equal, so four oils, one from each element, and two of each gender. I do not use Sage. I do a lot of entity banishments, and through this work, I have found that sage has become “sticky.” I think it has been overused by people who do not know what they are doing. I also infuse the cards with Reiki.

For consecrating, I use Cypress, Frankincense, Myrrh, and Lavender. Cypress is earth and female. Its traditional uses are for blessing and consecration. It promotes happiness, peace, wisdom, protection, harmony, and healing. Frankincense is male and fire. It is used for anointing, blessing, and exorcism. It enhances power, spiritual growth, and strength. Myrrh is female and water. Myrrh is used for blessing, consecration, purification, and exorcisms. Myrrh enhances healing, contemplation, and success. It raises our vibration and connects us to divine love. Lavender is male, and air used for purification, harmony, anointing, expanding awareness, business, and enhancing the conscious mind.

For blessing, I use Cypress, Lavender, Rosemary, and Rose. Rosemary is male and fire. It is used for banishing, cleansing, exorcism, purification, and luck. Rose is female, and water traditionally used for anointing, balance, healing, love, protection, and clairvoyance.

On a Sunday or Monday, during a sun or Moon hour, I anoint three candles —white, black, and blue —with the oils I've prepared, and then light them. I pass the deck through the smoke and speak the following:

“ I demand and command through the presence of I Am that I Am that these cards be consecrated, blessed, and cleared of all negative energy, remaining protected for all time. Furthermore, I command that these cards be a vehicle for Divine truth, light, and love. I give thanks for it is done.”

I then let the cards sit with the candles until the candles burn down completely.

Let me explain why I am including this in this lesson. First, I want you to succeed. Additionally, we have embarked on a journey to seek guidance. Specifically, we have sought guidance from external sources. When we do that, two things happen. First, our psychic abilities “turn on.” We begin to know things. If we are out of the way and do not have blocks, we will continuously enhance our second sight through using Tarot.

The second thing that will occur is opening ourselves up to spirit. Spirits are abundant in the various dimensional planes of our reality. Many would love a voice that could communicate with those of us in a body. Unfortunately, the psychic industry is filled with scammers and crackpots. Many people who are not so ethical or who lead us down a fantastical path started out as good people who wanted to help. But having opened themselves up to spirit, they became heavily influenced by spirit.

If you're a student of spiritual things, you know that there is light and dark. You know that as it is above, so it is below; as it is within, so it is without. You know this. So, if you look at the world, tell me you don't see evil. It's there. So, if that's the truth of the physical universe, then it is the truth of the spiritual world. If it is without, it is within.

Blessing and consecrating your cards protects them from such influences. It is also important to protect yourself from such influences. Who is the new client you have just connected to? What spirit is connecting with them? Who just walked through your door?

I would like to share with you a recently channeled mini-meditation that I received from the Ascended Masters. It will ground and protect you. I suggest using this as you start your day and before you go to sleep; I do.

Exhale completely. Now take a deep breath through your nose and release it through your mouth. Do this again.

Imagine yourself within a diamond, your crystal wings apparent. See your wings expand as golden light streams from the heavens into your crown chakra. A green light shines into the point at the bottom, grounding you to the planet. See the golden light flow down your spine through your chakras, cleansing, healing, and opening them. With this vision intact and breath taken, speak, "As it is above, so it is below. As it is within, so it is without. I am a crystal-winged being of radiant white fire. The golden light of the Divine flows through me. I stand upon this ground, my connection secure. I demand and command through the presence of I am that I am, that I, a spirit in perfect time, decree this change. My misbeliefs are rewritten. I call upon the Violet Flame of Love and Transformation to complete this work, transforming all into love and light. I give thanks for it is done, it is done, it is done."

Now, see a pink light within your heart while you yourself are standing in the violet light of the Violet flame. See that light expand, filling your aura. surrounding you. Allow the healing lights to create peace within you. You are now protected and grounded.

When the phone rings, a chat opens, or a client is about to enter your space, you can see the diamond around you to reinforce the protection.

I know this is necessary in part because I recently discovered how I was influenced by spirit in a way I was not aware of. I have felt secure because I only speak to the Ascended Masters. I figured I was safe. Then, a friend of mine offered me her new service (<https://www.ayeeya-activator.com/>). Part of the service included a scan for etheric tags. Etheric tags are spiritual tags placed on our energetic bodies by spirits who wish to monitor and impede our growth.

I have heard psychics and Tarot readers state that spirit do not influence them. I'm sorry, but this is just bullshit. It truly is. We are all influenced by spirit and our own subconscious, for that matter. After discovering the tags and their removal, my situation changed dramatically. I have worked with my friend to uncover things for many of my clients. We have found etheric tags, attached entities, and portals in their homes. We will look at these issues in a future class.

In the meantime, you may be wondering why I didn't know about this earlier. So did I! I asked why this had gone unnoticed for so long. Guidance said, "You never asked, but you weren't ready for the answer." This brings us back to the note from the first lesson: accurate readings depend on the right questions.

Answers To When Questions

Now that we have identified some issues that prevent us from obtaining accurate answers and found solutions to those problems, let's discuss how to time events. There are two systems to choose from. I will go over each one. Regardless of which one you choose, there are two things that you need to do before you go on to get answers.

First, set your intention. Simply speak the intention out loud, as speaking it aloud empowers it.

Second, shuffle the deck. Our hands are conduits for spiritual energy. By shuffling the deck, we are infusing it with energy. You will want to shuffle from your projective hand to your receptive hand. To determine your projective hand, interlace your fingers. The thumb that ends up on top indicates your projective hand. While you shuffle, ask the question in your mind. Express gratitude for the answer, which tells Guidance that the answer is yours.

Let's begin with how to utilize the first system.

The First System

Pull your first card. This will give the basic time frame. Another thing that can happen when you ask Tarot for a time is that the card may be reversed. I take this to mean that there are blocks in place that must be worked through for something to happen. Your interpretation of the card and subjectivity play a significant role here.

If the first card is from the Major Arcana, there are twelve that refer to a specific astrological sign and, therefore, the corresponding dates. We will fine-tune this and determine specific dates later. This and other tables are included in the Worksheets. Here is the list;

Aries - March 21 - April 19 The Emperor
 Taurus - April 20 - May 20 The Hierophant
 Gemini - May 21 - June 20 The Lovers
 Cancer - June 21 - July 22 The Chariot
 Leo - July 23 - August 22 Strength
 Virgo - August 23 - September 22 The Hermit
 Libra - September 23 - October 22 Justice
 Scorpio - October 23 - November 21 Death
 Sagittarius - November 22 - December 21 Temperance
 Capricorn - December 22 - January 19 The Devil
 Aquarius - January 20 - February 18 The Star
 Pisces - February 19 - March 20 The Moon

If you pull one of the other ten Major Arcana, they correspond to planets. These are the planets they correspond with, along with their meanings.

The Fool - Uranus Spontaneously & unpredictably
 The Magician - Mercury - Wednesday - A Mercury Hour - Quickly & skillfully
 The High Priestess - Moon - Monday - Moon Hour - At a new moon
 The Empress - Venus - Friday - Venus Hour - During Libra or Taurus
 Wheel of Fortune - Jupiter - Thursday - Jupiter Hour - Without notice, at any time
 The Hanged Man - Neptune - Event might not happen; change is necessary (it's hung up)
 The Tower - Mars - Tuesday - Mars Hour - At an inconvenient time, without warning
 The Sun - Sun - Sunday - Sun Hour - During the daytime, probably summer
 Judgement - Pluto - After great spiritual transformation
 The World - Saturn - Saturday - Saturn Hour - Very slowly, at least a year

You can see that some of these cards can also represent a specific day or hour. This is something you can use after you have determined specific weeks. This can also be used for questions about things you are confident will happen soon or during a specific period. The latter is especially helpful when asking what the best hour is for me to _____? If a specific day is unknown, start with the day first and then find the hour.

You can calculate the Planetary hour if you know how. Or, to determine when the planetary hour is, go to <https://geotimedate.org/planetary-hours/usa/pa/reading>. Another option for Windows system users is to download the software I have used for decades: Lunabar. You can get it here: https://infra-azure.com/?page_id=49

In this system, the Minor Arcana gives us seasons instead of Astrological Signs. They also give us time frames within those signs. This is the breakdown:

Wands, Spring, Days, Quickly
 Cups, Summer, Months, Mixed
 Swords, Fall, Weeks, Quickly
 Pentacles, Winter, Years, Slowly

When asked, "When will I get a job?" you pull Five of Cups. Using the Seasons correspondence, a job comes after June 21. I use the Solstices and Equinoxes to mark the seasons: Spring starts between March 20 and 22; Summer starts between June 20 and 22; Fall starts between September 20 and 22; and Winter starts between December 20 and 22. It's a little different every year. Lunabar will provide you with the exact dates. Alternatively, you can Google them.

If you pull The Emperor as the first card, it states that the event will occur while the Sun is in Aries. Once you have determined a season or time frame, you can also fine-tune the date using Numerology. Your next question is, during which of the four weeks will the event occur while the Sun is in Aries? If your next card is the Three of Cups, its normal meaning in terms of timing is during the Summer or in three months. However, we have already determined the month and are asking for the week. We use Numerology, and the Three of Cups says, "in the third week."

But why this card? There are plenty of threes in Tarot. This is when Tarot wants to deliver a message. The Three of Cups tells us that she will get a job with people she likes and has a good time with as they celebrate the fruits of their labor.

Now we can ask for the day within the third week. If we pull the Two of Wands, the answer would be the second day, or Monday. If we pull The Tower, the answer would be

on Wednesday. The same process would be used to determine the hour.

Let's review some more examples.

If you pull the Four of Wands, you get an easy answer: Four days. Then we determine the hour and pull The Emperor, getting during a Mars Hour.

Pulling the Three of Swords, the answer is three weeks. The next card will indicate which day in that time period a job will be retained, as determined by Planet or Numerology. If the next card you pull is The High Priestess, and your intuition agrees, the answer could be at the next New Moon; if not, or if there is no New Moon in that period, the answer would be Monday.

If you pull the Ace of Swords Reversed, there is no answer. Reversed cards indicate that there is no clear answer and that obstacles must be overcome to achieve the goal. In the case of the Ace of Swords, the message is: "You have to gain control of the thoughts in your head that keep it from happening." Why? Ace of Swords is all about the thoughts we have. Do they command our chosen reality, or are they running rampant? Reversed, they are running rampant. There's work to do. So, Tarot says there is no answer: The answer depends on the querent's commitment to working on self.

Here are a few other examples using the question, "When will my finances stabilize?"

Answer: Three of Pentacles - Pentacles equal Years. The Numerology states three.

Second Card (when in this period): Ten of Pentacles says in the winter.

Third Card (when in the period designated by the second card): Ten of Cups - Tenth week

Fourth Card Judgement: Spiritual work that leads to transformation is needed to make this happen.

Answer: Eight of Pentacles - Eight years.

Second Card: The Magician Reversed - There are skills to obtain.

There are many words and phrases for each card. The Magician Reversed could also indicate that the querent isn't taking action or does not possess the necessary tools. In the worksheets, I have included how The Magician sees himself as a person and in relationships, both upright and reversed. This is written in his own words, using phrases

and words taken from the symbolism. This is so you can see how complex the answers can be and begin learning how to “write sentences” with Tarot.

If Tarot gives a time frame through the first card but the second or third does not, it simply means that there is no additional information regarding timing. Instead, the card that leaves you at a dead end in terms of timing tells you what is in the way and, therefore, what work has to be done.

The Second System

The second system for timing events with Tarot is based on the Astrological signs or planets that the cards correspond to. This system utilizes an astrological tarot wheel and shares some similarities with the previous system, particularly in its interpretation of the Major Arcana. It shows ten-day time frames indicated by the Minor Arcana. The wheel is somewhat self-explanatory, and you will find it accompanied by tables that provide the exact interpretations in the worksheets.

I apply some of the same rules from the first system, but I do not use reverses in this system. Again, the first card provides the basic time frame, and we proceed from there. The second card once again indicates when during the period given by the first card. If there is no precise answer after a card, I do not continue. For example, once I get the time frame, if a day is not given within that time frame, I do not ask for the hour.

The wheel is identical to an Astrology chart. It has twelve sections, each divided into three parts called Decans. A planet rules each Decan, which gives us a specific day for the sections ruled by the inner planets. Cards ruled by Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are not associated with days, so pulling one of these cards leads to guidance, not a time frame. This gets tricky, as there may be two Mondays or Tuesdays within a ten-day period, and so on. Hours can also be identified this way through the planetary hours.

One of the highlights of this system is the clues it provides about the personalities of the court cards. If you see the cards as characters in a story, as I do, this system tells you a lot about them.

For example, the Queen of Wands is associated with the Third Decan of Pisces and the First and Second Decans of Aries.

The Third Decan of Pisces is influenced by Scorpio and ruled by Pluto. This combination introduces a dynamic intensity, where Aries' drive for action starts to emerge. As a result, individuals born in this decan are always on the verge of transformation, fueled by Scorpio's depth and Pluto's power. They have a strong sense of wonder and a greater inclination toward taking risks than other Pisces decans. If change isn't happening fast enough, they'll take matters into their own hands, as they are deeply committed to personal evolution and transformation.

The First Decan of Aries is Aries itself, ruled by Mars, which amplifies its impulsiveness, spontaneity, and boundless energy. Mars's influence makes Aries highly assertive, so they are naturally drawn to debates, confrontations, and challenges. However, they constantly struggle to rein in their infamous temper, knowing that their words have the power to cut deep.

Their boldness and unpredictability often earn them labels such as assertive, arrogant, or selfish, yet their unshakable self-confidence is a defining trait. When harnessed effectively, their raw energy leads to success. However, they refuse to be controlled or tamed, fiercely resisting any force that attempts to restrain their independent spirit.

The Second Decan of Aries is influenced by Leo and ruled by the Sun. It embodies warmth, passion, and an energetic presence. These individuals naturally stand out, radiating confidence and charisma. Their desire for harmony in life is strong as they strive to maintain balance. Notably, this decan is often called the "Week of the Star," highlighting their natural leadership qualities.

Since the Sun represents the will and main identity, Aries individuals may sometimes exhibit more self-centered tendencies. They prioritize their own desires and struggle to accept differing perspectives. Their innate sense of independence and authority makes it difficult to tolerate being told what to do.

On the positive side, their leadership skills and strong moral compass often shape them into principled individuals. While other astrological factors can influence their character, they are generally known for their honesty and integrity, rarely resorting to deception or dishonesty. They have a strong sense of justice and a clear understanding of right and wrong.

This information certainly provides valuable insights into the personality of the



Queen of Wands. Adding other symbolic clues to the card creates a well-rounded story of her identity. The same is true for all Court Cards, except the Pages.

The Pages are connected to The Aces. The Aces and Pages share a unique relationship in Tarot systems. The Aces represent the pure essence or root energy of their respective elements (Wands, Cups, Swords, and Pentacles), while the Pages act as their physical manifestation or vehicle in the material world.

The Ace is like a seed, containing its suit's raw, undirected potential. The Page (Princess) takes that energy and grounds it into reality, giving it form and direction. Thus, whenever an Ace appears in a tarot reading, it signals the beginning of something powerful but still in its early stages, while the presence of a Page indicates that this energy is actively manifesting or taking shape in the real world.

The Aces and Pages can provide timing clues in tarot readings, but these are indicators of seasons rather than precise dates. Their connection to astrological signs allows broad timeframes to be inferred, typically covering a three-month period.

This system is intricate and complicated. However, it contains a wealth of information and insight. You can also add components such as the Numerology.

Let's review some examples of this system.

"When will I get a job?"

Answer: 1st card - Five of Cups = Between October 21 and November 1.

2nd card - Four of Cups = Unknown.

Caveat: Great loss (Five of Cups), there's something you're not accepting (Four of Cups).

Answer: 1st card - Ace of Swords = In the winter

2nd card - Wheel of Fortune = Tenth week (based on Numerology)

3rd card - The World = On a Saturday

Caveat: A decision (Ace of Swords), you come into fortune (Wheel of Fortune) and feel liberated (The World).

"When will I meet someone to date?"



Answer: 1st card - Three of Pentacles - Between January 1 and 11.

2nd card (to clarify when in the ten-day period) - Ten of Pentacles = on a Friday
(based on the Planet)

3rd card (to clarify the hour) Ten of Cups = Unknown - transformation necessary
(based on Planet)

Caveat: Talking with others (Three of Pentacles) with an established group or family gathering (Ten of Pentacles), your dreams are fulfilled (Ten of Cups).

This system may seem daunting, but it is simply a matter of referencing the provided tables.

Both systems can create some frustrations. We're not always supposed to know. Pulling The Fool gives us one of those frustrating moments because The Fool gives us so little in terms of timing. This is because The Fool corresponds with the planet Uranus, which rules earthquakes. At this stage of our evolution, we cannot predict earthquakes. The Fool says you can't predict time here. I wish I had a TV that was solely focused on the future. Alas, I do not. Much to my and my clients' chagrin. What I do know is that sometimes I don't know. It took me a while to feel ok with telling a client, I don't know. Think about embracing those three words. It's ok to say them.

Though I would advise you to choose a system, the truth is that the Tarot may have other ideas. Tarot will answer your questions in the system it sees you ready for. I often ask a question and get guidance on the issue at hand, but the question remains unanswered. This happens for clients as well, especially when they have called multiple psychics, asking the same question. A passage in the I Ching describes a student asking the teacher a question. The first time, the teacher answers. The second time, though a bit perturbed, the teacher answers the question. The third time, the teacher sends the student away. You may not always know what your client has done before working with her. Tarot will use the system and give answers that align with her spiritual growth. It may not always be appropriate to share specific dates.

We must always allow for free will. Free Will often means choosing to learn specific lessons, work through specific karma, or heal specific wounds to achieve our goals. At times, our goals are not in alignment with this. We have all obsessed over a specific outcome when that outcome is not in our highest good. When asking Tarot a question addressing an issue we have to work on, the Tarot may choose to give us Guidance, not facts.



You will discover which system you align with when you use the worksheets to practice timing events.

Your intuition and discernment are always necessary when providing answers. Even when we are just providing dates. Checking your answers against the Astrological influences is helpful. Astrology always trumps Numerology, so I don't recommend Numerology as the first choice without the insights given by Astrology. If you're not ready for that, I recommend using a pendulum. If you use a pendulum, ensure the chain is silver, and the crystal is associated with the Sixth Chakra.

Conclusions

Your subjectivity will evolve over time, continually growing and offering deeper insights.

Preparing yourself and your cards enhances your ability to provide and receive accurate answers. Not doing so leads to confusion and a lack of true clarity.

Tarot has built-in timelines to provide you with the answers you seek.

Truth is not always available or pretty. However, truth, or a lack of answers, leads to expanded possibilities and opportunities.

Tarot is a powerful tool that adapts to your subjectivity and expands your understanding. As you practice timing events, remember to protect and ground yourself, safeguard your tools, and continually deepen your understanding of symbolism.

With two systems available, you must choose or discover which works best for you.

In the final lesson, we will discuss how to ask questions, complete exercises to help you hone your skills, and learn an easy meditation and exercise that will help you open your intuition. There is only one more lesson to complete. Congratulations on getting this far! I know there is a lot to absorb. Hopefully, the worksheets will help you grasp these concepts.

So, let's take a deep breath. Breathe in a sense of knowing all we have learned today. Stretch, move, and let your body in on all the points of light and knowledge you have gained.



Clearing

We will also ensure nothing is in the way of you using this knowledge. I will help you clear some of the mind's naysayers through a quick fix. Work with me here to begin silencing those voices that do not support your power to obtain prophetic knowledge.

Before we start, let me warn you: You may be hesitant when you speak these words. The first time I did this, I thought, "I'm not willing to experience this." But I was. Every thought, concept, thing, and feeling is energy. When we acknowledge that, we see it for what it is. We wouldn't be experiencing it if we hadn't chosen to at some point. By recognizing it as energy and our choice to experience it, we can choose to let it go. Let's do this, and you'll see what I'm discussing.

Take a deep breath through your nose and release it slowly. Pay attention to your feet. Wiggle your toes. Take another deep breath, releasing it slowly.

Now repeat after me:

This not knowing.

This energy of not knowing.

This pure energy of not knowing.

This pure energy of not knowing is not personal.

This pure energy of not knowing is not personal.

This pure energy of not knowing is not personal, and I am willing to experience it.

Now be inwardly still. Let go and give yourself space to simply be with your experience. If emotion, physical sensation, or thought arises, simply be still and allow the process to unfold until you feel a natural completion.

Clarity

This clarity.

This energy of clarity.

This pure energy of clarity.

Again, be inwardly still. Let go and give yourself space to simply be with your experience. If emotion, physical sensation, or thought arises, be still and allow the process to unfold until you feel a natural completion.



Etheric tags are often found:

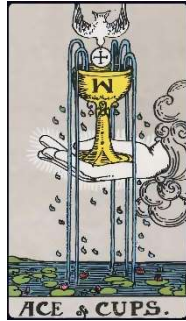
- After trauma or spiritual vulnerability

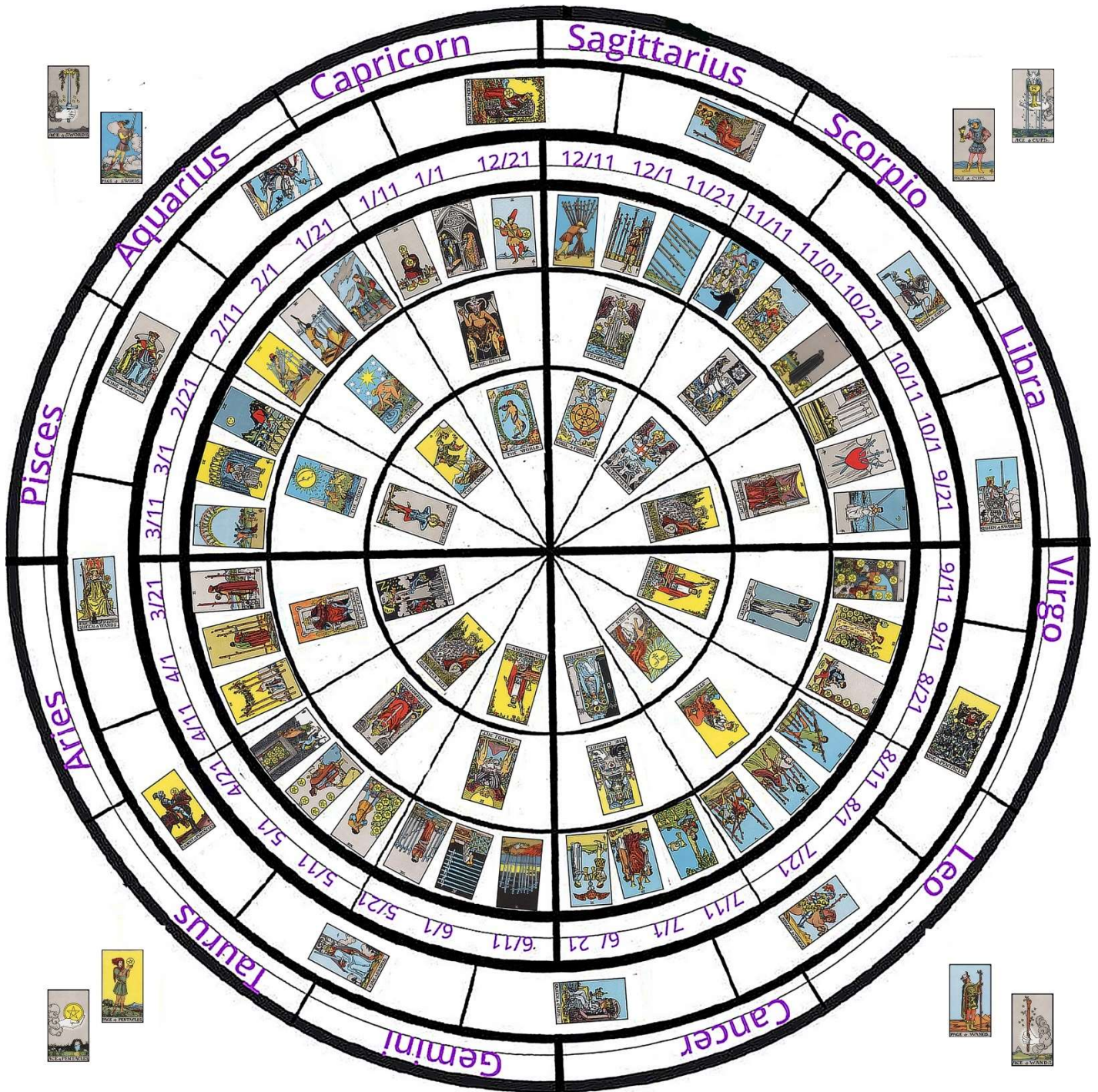





Minor Arcana Cards Two through Ten

The table shows the Dates in order, in alignment with the wheel.

The dates change each year. To be exact, you must check when the Sun enters a sign, indicating the First Decan. When it reaches 10 degrees of the sign, it enters the Second Decan; when it is at 20 degrees, it enters the Third Decan. Each Decan, and therefore card, contains 10 days. This becomes extremely important if you try to narrow down when, in those ten days, something will occur. If you pull another card and the card's number is between 1 and 10, signifying which of those ten days is the one, you will want to know when the period started exactly.

How to tell a story from the image using The Magicians' meaning words and sentences.

Remember where your eyes fall as you look at the card.

Your question will also influence your choice of words.

An upright Magician sets the table. Reversed, he won't set the table, won't do the dishes, but will eat the food.

The Magician introduces us to all the tools The Fool needs on his journey. The Magician talks The Fool out of his bag and reveals all of the elements necessary to realize his desires.

The Magician continued

Choosing your words and phrases depends on the question and where you find your attention going when looking at the card. Here is the meaning of some symbolism shown.

The snake, his belt, is a reference to the awakening of Kundalini energy. Kundalini lies at the base of the spine and rises up through the chakras, the spiritual energy centers within the body. Here is the idea of rising.

On the table are the tools, neatly organized, which represent the four suits of Tarot, which in turn represent the four elements. These are the tools necessary to materialize desires. We will talk more about the elements when we look at the suits of the Minor Arcana.

The figure eight above him is the lemniscate, the symbol of eternity. It speaks of forever, and unlimited potential.

His smile indicates his confidence.

His upraised arm points to the heavens, and his downturned arm points to Earth. He is drawing energy down from heaven to the earth, a conduit in this pose.

The number one is not only an indicator of a number, should your question require one, but its shape is also phallic. A shape repeated by the white magic wand.

A white headband, the color of purity, holds back his hair, disciplining it. It also suggests concentrating to accomplish goals.

Tips and Tricks

Do not confuse the phrases and words. The first, the first connection, or connection. They all come from different references. The first is about the number one. The first connection is about the fact that the Magician is the first person the Fool meets. Connection is about his ability to connect spiritual energy with earthly energy. Because they are different, they give you different possibilities when telling you the story. For example;

If the question was, *"When did they meet? Who is he to her?"* The Magician says, *"On the first, they connected, and he was her first connection to a man."*

The Magician continued

The Magician is always a man. First, because he is a man. Secondly, because of the phallic references and the number one, which is considered male. However, the actions he takes or the qualities he has could easily be attributed to a woman. For example, in a two-card spread;

“(a card specifying a woman) decided to make it happen.”

However, notice his face. There is a high level of androgyny present. If it were not for the number 1, there would be some question as to gender. The “prettiness” of his face may indicate some question about his sexual preferences.

The pronouns He, him, and his can be used independently when appropriate. For example;

What is he doing? He (The Magician) is traveling (The Fool).

A deeper look at The Magicians’ meaning, words, and sentences for a deeper story.

The preponderance of yellow is deliberate. Yellow is the color of Mercury, the planet and God of communication and intellect. This suggests that we must utilize our minds and communicate clearly to reach our goals. In fact, The Magician is all about intellect.

The other colors also have meaning. Red represents passion, activity, or fire, which are elements needed to make things happen. The white lilies and white wand represent purity, a quality needed to allow Divine energy to come through. Green represents Earth and growth.

References to Kundalini are spread throughout Tarot. The Rider Waite deck was designed to explore Spiritual development. The awakening and rising of Kundalini energy is one of the factors many esoteric schools believe is necessary for Spiritual growth.

The Magician continued

The Magician presents us with the concept that our will, when connected with Divine energy, allows us to gain knowledge. Our will also gains the power to manifest the things we desire. When drawn as a one-card spread, asking for Spiritual guidance, it tells us that all is possible when connected to Divine sources. We can only be connected to Divine sources when our egos are not in the way. Magic can go very wrong in ego-driven hands.

Regarding the journey to Spiritual Awakening, The Magician represents the first step the Fool takes.
